ACCESS TO THE [BRILL JOURNAL ARCHIVES ONLINE](#) INCLUDED IN (INSTITUTIONAL) SUBSCRIPTIONS

The Brill Journal Archives Online now offer access to over 85,000 articles (1.265 million pages) published before the year 2010, covering over 3,300 volumes of now 157 scholarly journals. The Journal Archives consist of two parts, the first covering the 19th and 20th century and the second part the first decade of the 21st century. The Archives hold the imprints Brill, Martinus Nijhoff and VSP.

Libraries will automatically have full access to the archival content of journals currently subscribed to, and will continue to have access to archival content for as long as active subscriptions are maintained. Libraries and consortia wishing to acquire the archives in perpetuity are able to purchase either subject packages or the entire collection of available archives. The Brill journal archive is hosted on Brill's online journals platform at *Ingenta*.

PLEASE ALSO NOTE THAT:

- **More than 140 titles** are now available **online** from Brill.
- For **institutions** three subscription options are available: **online only**, **print only** or **combined print plus online**.
- Access to the **complete electronic archive, going back to Volume 1, No. 1** (where applicable) is **included** in institutional subscriptions.
- An increasing number of Brill titles now offer **Fast Track** (advance online) article publication.
- **Individual** subscriptions (except *Logos* and *Oud Holland*) do **not** include online access.
- After cancellation, **perpetual access** is guaranteed to purchased online content since 2000.
- Long-term **preservation** of all electronic content is secured by arrangements with the Dutch National Library (NL) and Portico (USA).
- **Brill OPEN** offers authors the option to secure open access for their journal contributions.
- **Permissions** for re-use of article content can be obtained using [RightsLink](#).
- **COUNTER**-compliant library usage statistics are available (through *Ingenta*).
