

# The Brill Journal Archives Online

The Brill Journal Archives Online now offer access to over **85,000 articles** (1.265 million pages) published before the year 2010, covering over 3,300 volumes of now 157 scholarly journals. The Journal Archives consist of two parts, the first covering the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> century and the second the first decade of the 21<sup>st</sup> century. The Archives hold the imprints Brill, Martinus Nijhoff and VSP.

The archives include access to one of the world's oldest academic journals on Chinese studies, *T'oung Pao* (since 1890) and leading Brill journals such as *Behaviour* (since 1948), *Mnemosyne* (since 1948) and *Vetus Testamentum* (since 1951).

The academic community will find the Brill Journal Archives Online an invaluable resource for acquiring an historical perspective on the humanities, social sciences, international law & human rights, biology and some selected areas in the natural sciences.

The Brill Journal Archives Online offer the same features already familiar to users of Brill current journal content, such as full text search, navigation tools, etc.

Libraries will automatically have full access to the archives of all the journals they currently subscribe to, and will continue to have access for as long as active subscriptions are maintained.

Access to the Journal Archives ceases upon cancellation of a subscription, but institutional customers can purchase the whole archival collection or subject-specific collections, to ensure perpetual access. The Brill Journal Archives Online are exclusively hosted on IngentaConnect.

## NOW ALSO AVAILABLE: JOURNAL ARCHIVES PART II COVERING 2000-2009

The Journal Archives consist of two parts, the first covering the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> century and the second the first decennium of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

### ***Brill Journal Archives Online Part I: Archives from the 19th and 20th Century***

Part I of the Journal Archives comprises archival content of all 2200 volumes of 90 journals that were published before 2000. This part counts 49,000 articles with 735,000 pages. The archival content starts with volume 1 issue 1 and goes up to the last issue published in 1999. It includes journals which were previously published under different names and/or by another publisher.

### ***Brill Journal Archives Online Part 2: Archives from the 21th Century***

Part II adds another 36,000 articles with 530,000 pages to the Journal Archives. This part covers all 1100 volumes of 154 journals that were published in the ten-year period 2000-2009.

## FEATURES

The Brill Journal Archives Online are hosted on IngentaConnect and offer all the features our users have grown accustomed to: full text search, extensive linking and other navigation tools, full text PDF downloads, and saving and printing facilities. Brill is a CROSSREF member and ATHENS, SHIBBOLETH, and COUNTER compliant.

## ARCHIVAL ACCESS RIGHTS INCLUDED IN CURRENT SUBSCRIPTIONS

Libraries have automatic access to the archival content of all journals currently subscribed to, and will continue to have access to archival content for as long as subscriptions are maintained. Libraries who have already activated online access to their Brill journals need take no further action; the archival content will be made available to them automatically.

Should a library decide to discontinue its subscription to a Brill journal, access to the archival content of that particular journal will be disabled. In line with Brill's archival policy, access to all subscribed volumes published since 2000 continues after cancellation.

## PURCHASE OPTIONS

Although access to the Journal Archive of individual journals is included in the journal's subscription price, institutional customers may wish to consider purchasing the whole collection or subject-specific collections.

The purchase option guarantees perpetual access to the Brill Journal Archives Online. Brill has a long-term archival and preservation agreement with the Royal Dutch Library (KB), and with Portico (USA).

Additionally, a purchase of the archives enables libraries to save shelf space and to provide their users with the online archives of journals currently not subscribed to.
